ROLE OVERVIEW

The Mental Health Services Manager will facilitate the implementation of Urban Bridge Mental Health Services and programs, as well as, directly provide mental health services to individuals and groups.

PURPOSE OF ROLE

This role will also assist other therapeutic service providers at The Bridge Impact Center and other off-site locations (e.g. local middle and high schools) in providing services via coordination and implementation of mental health services and program delivery - serving students, families, and/or community members. The Mental Health Services Manager also oversees the day-to-day operations of Mental Health Services at The Bridge Impact Center. This position is responsible for the supervision of staff and compliance with all state and local regulations. He or she will report to the Mental Health Services Director.

QUALIFICATIONS

- LPC or equivalent and Oklahoma license
- 5 plus years of management and supervisory experience
- Demonstrated experience with mental and behavioral health therapy.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills.
- Experience working with under-served communities & understanding of cultural diversity preferred.
- Experience in a position that required attention to multiple tasks.
- Ability to take initiative and manage responsibilities and workload as well as perform under pressure, and think quickly in unusual/stressful situations.
- Commitment to and alignment with the mission of Urban Bridge.
- 2+ years experience working with students.
