## LOOKING BACK

URBAN BRIDGE WAS FOUNDED IN 2015 BY 3 COMMUNITY LEADERS AND PASSIONATE CHANGE-MAKERS - MARCUS JACKSON, VERNON DEAS, AND JAMES JACKSON. THESE MEN HAD A COMMITTED DESIRE TO IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF LIFE IN THE COMMUNITIES SERVED THROUGH EDUCATION, EXPOSURE, EMPOWERMENT, AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT. ALMOST 4 YEARS AFTER INCORPORATING AS A NONPROFIT THEY FINALLY EXPERIENCED SOME FUNDING AND OPPORTUNITY BREAKTHROUGHS. ENABLING MARCUS TO FOCUS FULL-TIME ON REALIZING THE HOPES AND DREAMS THAT WERE BIRTHED MANY YEARS PRIOR. IN 2021, FACILITY RENOVATIONS WERE COMPLETED AND THE GRAND OPENING TO THE COMMUNITY WAS HELD. **EDUCATION** - THROUGH ACADEMIC INCENTIVE PROGRAMS, READING AND MATH COACHING, TUTORING, STEM, AND CREATIVE ARTS PROGRAMS, EDUCATIONAL ADVANCEMENT OCCURS AND ACADEMIC GOALS ARE ACHIEVED.



**EXPOSURE** - INDIVIDUAL AND COLLECTIVE CAPACITY IS BUILT IN THE COMMUNITY THROUGH FOCUS AND OPPORTUNITY WITH TECHNOLOGY AND CODING, HEALTH & WELLNESS PROGRAM, CULTURAL EVENTS, AND FIELD TRIPS.



## OUR PROGRAMS



THE BRIDGE IMPACT CENTER: RUN BY MARCUS JACKSON, THE BRIDGE IMPACT CENTER STRIVES TO CREATE AN ENVIRONMENT AND POSITIVELY IMPACTS YOUTH, FAMILIES, AND NEIGHBORHOODS IN TRADITIONALLY UNDER-REPRESENTED COMMUNITIES THROUGH MENTORING, TUTORING, COLLEGE & CAREER PREPARATIONS, FINANCIAL LITERACY, THE ARTS, SPRITUAL DEVELOPMENT AND COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS. IN ADDITION TO MEETING BASIC LIFE NEEDS, THE BRIDGE OFFERS BOTH ONSITE AND OFF-SITE PROGRAMS STRUCTURED TO CREATE FORMATIVE, HOLISTIC DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOUTH AND YOUNG ADULTS.

COMMUNITY ADVOCACY & PARTNERSHIPS: URBAN BRIDGE PARTNERS WITH CIVIC, GOVERNMENT, COMMUNITY-BASED, AND PARTNERS THROUGH THE BRIDGE IMPACT CENTER TO CREATE AND DELIVER RESOURCES FOR NEIGHBORHOOD STABILIZATION AND REVITALIZATION AND ADVANCES INITIATIVES TO HELP EMPOWER CITIZENS AND COMBAT GENERATIONAL POVERTY.
